Dear Emma, I thank you for your contact in respect of Felldownhead Road and the forthcoming roadworks. The roadworks in question will be carried out using traffic signals rather than a road closure so there would be no requirement for Devon County Council to sign a diversion or introduce a temporary traffic order on any adjacent roads. We have reported the damaged sign and this will be attended to in due course. In respect of the other issues you have mentioned I can only reiterate the sentiments expressed in my colleagues previous response to the parish and have attached a copy for reference. Neither the scale of the issue or the safety record on Felldownhead Road justify intervention by the Highway Authority and we are unable to implement any further changes in respect of this road.

We appreciate the sentiments of the residents but trust that they will also appreciate that our resources are limited and have to be prioritised accordingly. All roads are monitored in terms of safety and issues are addressed as appropriate in line with our policy. You will appreciate that this road has been discussed many times and we are now in a position where we have done all that we are able. Should there be a time when Devon County Council need to implement changes we will keep the parish fully informed.
